Today, ODE released guidance for reopening our schools and the related documents are attached.

1. What other relevant information is available?

2. When will reopening plans be finalized and can I participate in creating the plan?
 - a. The plan must be finalized before students can return to campus for instruction. If you would like to serve as a volunteer on the steering committee, send your request to me at steve.woods@dayscreek.k12.or.us and I will follow up with guidance.
3. Please summarize the main points
 - a. ODE is giving every school district the opportunity to construct their own re-opening plan.
 - b. Days Creek will be moving forward with a plan for all students (K-12) to be back on campus with onsite instruction and learning in a classroom environment that is safe and productive.
 - c. Information related to athletics and transportation is coming from ODE. We want to get kids back on campus as soon as it is safe and allowed. We will let you know once guidance is given.
 - d. There will be multiple changes along the way. ODE is scheduled to give updates every 3 weeks (June 30, July 21 and August 11). OHA will be monitoring outbreaks and shifts in plans.
 - e. It appears, face coverings for students will be allowed should a student want to wear one, but face coverings will not be required for students.
 - f. Face coverings are required for some staff, and recommended for others.
 - g. The district plan will be constructed based on ODE mandates and community input. "Recommendations" are not "requirements" and the district will have a level of discretion to decide what we will be implementing throughout the year.
4. When will classes begin?
 - a. **Douglas County SD 15 – Days Creek Charter School will be constructing a plan to begin the school year as planned.** The 2020-21 school year calendar can be [found here](#).
