Here are some additional reminders and updates:

2. Teachers are preparing to deliver instructional support to you digitally (if you have internet access), or physically for you to pick up at school or at your bus stop. **The plan is to begin off-campus instruction on April 1.**
3. Expect a call from a teacher or school employee March 30 or 31. The call is to gather important information that will guide us in our plan forward.
4. **Seniors** – we were expecting final guidelines very soon, and I believe whatever decisions are made, you will be given the flexibility to earn your High School diploma. For now, complete the work you have been given and if there are resources you need from your locker or at school, please give me or one of the administrators a call and we will make the necessary accommodations.
